

C. How to Find Your PLACE in Ministry.

(Suggested teaching time: 10 minutes)

We will present five areas that help you get to know yourself better and understand others so that you can find your PLACE in ministry and reach your fullest potential. We will use the letters P-L-A-C-E.

Let the group know that each of these aspects of PLACE will be presented in this module with an assessment tool for each.

1. P – Personality Type.

There are four basic temperament types that identify distinct personality attributes. Each person is a unique mix of these four types, but can usually be described by a primary and secondary blend of two of them.

Let the group know that Sessions 2 and 3 focus on Personality Types.

2. L – Likes & Love.

You must identify what is planted in your heart in terms of what you really like to do and find the God-given love or passion you have for ministry.

Let the group know that Session 7 focuses on Likes & Love.

3. A – Availability.

Any ministry assignment requires time commitment and availability. You must assess your time available and see if it matches the ministry role you desire to fulfill.

Let the group know that Session 7 focuses on Availability.

4. C – Charismata Gifts. (Ro 12)

God gives believers spiritual gifts. The seven gifts presented in Ro 12:6-8 describe some of the key functions or motivations that help you find your place of service. You should be able to identify your top three functional Ro 12 gifts.

Let the group know that Session 6 focuses on Charismata Gifts.

5. E – Experience & Skills.

Reflecting on your successful life experiences and acquired skills should help you to find your place in ministry service. You will most likely see areas or patterns of experiences where you have shown fruit and joy.

Let the group know that Session 7 focuses on Experience & Skills.
